SJEDS' goal is to develop the long-term stable funding base and sustainable economic development programs to move San Juan County's economy forward.

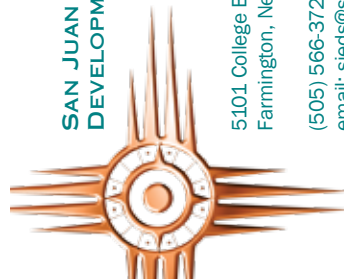
